## State Trooper not mething around



**State Trooper Lt. Mike Goff** visited the Main Office on Thursday Jan. 19 to educate our HospiceCare CNAs and other staff members on the dangers of crystal methamphetamine and telltale signs of in-home meth labs and drug abuse. Lt. Goff detailed the everyday household medicines and other items that people use to make meth to raise awareness among our staff that might be put at risk going into families' homes to care for patients. The toxic and criminal nature of meth production creates a hazard for anyone coming into a home where such activity is taking place. With more than 300 meth lab busts taking place statewide in the past year, the meth epidemic is showing no signs of slowing down

despite recent declines in the number of such labs following the implementation of more stringent law enforcement measures a few years ago, Lt. Goff said. The purpose of his talk, however, was not to scare our staff, but to raise awareness of the harmful physical, emotional and social effects the drug and its production have on the people and communities we serve.

## Love Light Tree raises over \$77,000

Nearly 1,200 donors contributed \$77,680 to the 28th annual Love Light Tree fundraising campaign. While numbers are off from last year's record-setting total, it is still the second largest total ever for the campaign and more than \$4,000 more than was given in 2009. Thank you to the more than 300 hospice and community volunteers (*listed on page 5*) who gave their time and energy to staff the trees at Charleston Town Center Mall, Boone Memorial Hospital and various locations around Lewisburg.
